Corporate Carbon Footprint Disclosure Introduction

Corporate Carbon Footprint (CCF) represents a crucial metric in the world of environmental sustainability, that comprehensively measures a company's direct and indirect greenhouse gas emissions. This assessment is critical for organizations aiming to understand and mitigate their impact on climate change. By systematically calculating their CCF, businesses can identify key areas where emissions are highest, set realistic reduction targets, and develop strategies to decrease their carbon footprint.

Emissions from the Supply Chain have a critical impact. Traditionally, corporations were only expected to calculate and mitigate their direct influence on the environment. **Moving forward, businesses must comprehend both direct and indirect emissions originating from their supply chain.**

To gain transparency on the Supply Chain emissions, your customer has requested SupplyOn to send out this Corporate Carbon Footprint disclosure on their behalf.



Definition of Terms:

The Corporate Carbon Footprint (CCF) comprises all relevant greenhouse gas emissions of a company. It's essential to understand it as the total accumulation of greenhouse gas emissions in CO2 equivalents attributed to a corporation. This encompasses both the direct and indirect emissions across the organization divided into three distinct categories or 'scopes':

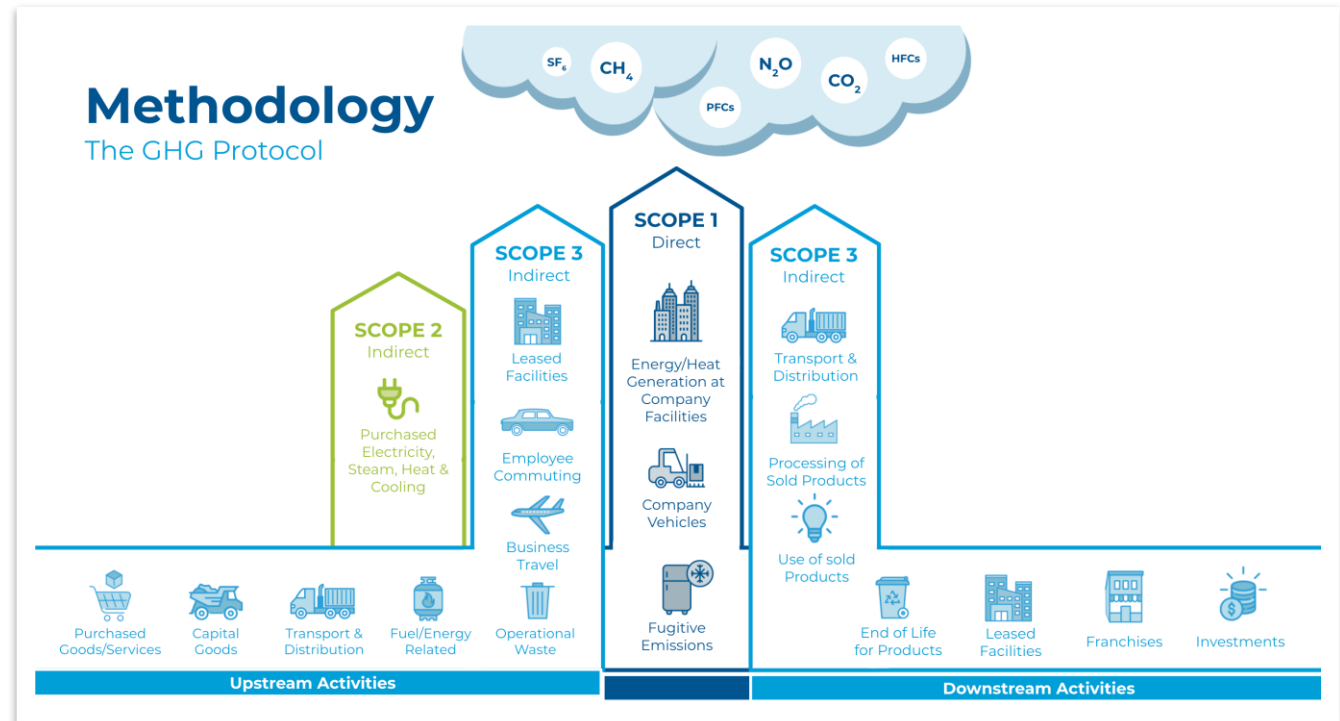
- **Scope I** pertains to emissions that occur directly at the site in question. This typically involves the release of greenhouse gases through the combustion of fossil fuels (like natural gas or heating oil) or emissions from vehicles owned by the company.
- **Scope II** accounts for emissions that are indirectly caused and controlled by the company, through the generation of electricity, steam, heat, and cooling that the company purchases and utilizes within the assessment period.
- **Scope III** covers upstream and downstream indirect emissions in a company's value chain. This can include emissions associated with procured goods or raw materials, as well as emissions from business-related travel and transportation activities. **This CCF disclosure is ONLY asking about scope 3 upstream activities.**

ESG stands for Environmental, Social, and Governance factors of a company

Green Energy (as in EU taxonomy) is a smaller subset of renewable energies and only includes those sources with a low environmental impact. For example, large-scale hydropower may be renewable but is not considered green due to the large impacts dams have on the environment.

Renewable Energy is any form of electricity produced from natural sources that either never run out or is replenished over a short period of time. While solar and wind are the main forms, it also includes hydro, geothermal, and biomass.

Energy Mix Share is a percentage of energy that comes from a certain source, often provided by electric utility or on-site solar.

What are location based and market based calculation methods?

Assistant

Location-based and market-based methods are two approaches used to allocate GHG emissions created by electricity generation to the end consumers of a given grid. The location-based method reflects the average emissions intensity of grids on which energy consumption occurs, while the market-based method reflects the GHG emissions associated with the choices a consumer makes regarding its electricity supplier or product. The location-based method is based on statistical emissions information and electricity output aggregated and averaged within a defined geographic boundary and during a defined time period, while the market-based method represents contractual information and claims flow, which may be different from underlying energy flows in the grid.
